CODES OF CONDUCT

Sport plays an important role in the lives of many Australians. We participate for different reasons, from social interaction to serious competition, but for some it all gets a little too serious. Everyone involved in sport has the right to participate in a safe and supportive environment.

Sometimes players, coaches, spectators and parents, get over zealous and spoil the experience for others. They need to be reminded that there are appropriate forms of behaviour when involved in sport.

A number of recent ugly incidents whereby parents and spectators verbally and physically abused officials and coaches has increased the need for all sports to develop their own codes of behaviour.

The Wimmera Tennis Region 2 endorses the Australian Sports Commission's Codes of Behaviour and encourages all member clubs to adopt these codes as a part of their club policies. Free copies of all codes can be downloaded from their website at www.ausport.gov.au For your information below are the codes for players and parents.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials, sledging other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in any sport.
- Work equally hard for yourself and/or your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them, there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please your parents and coaches.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than whether they win or lose.
- Encourage children to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performance and skilful plays by all participants.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

FREE Club Development Network

A well run club is essential to providing quality sports participation at the grass roots level. To assist clubs improve their capacity and capability to deliver sport at the local level, the Australian Sports Commission's Club Development and Membership Growth Unit (CDMG) initiated the free web based Club Development Network. The Network caters for all types of clubs across all sports. The principle upon which the Club Development Network has been established is one of promoting continuous improvement. The CDMG Unit aims to assist clubs identify ways in which they can develop so as to provide the best possible service to their members. Guidelines for Prevention of Heat Illness in Sport

Vigorous exercise places some people at risk of heat illness, especially in hot weather. If untreated, heat illness can lead to the more serious and potentially life-threatening condition of heat stroke. Listen to your body and stop or slow down if you feel unwell. This is particularly important for children. Make sure that you have access to cool drinking water, wear a good hat and take particular care in the hottest parts of the day or year.

There are many factors to be considered when clubs and associations are contemplating modifying, postponing or cancelling sporting events or training. For normally healthy active people, the only dangers from heat illness are likely to arise from high intensity exercise such as endurance running. Most community sport does not reach this level for periods long enough to cause serious harm. Many types of sport, such as cricket and tennis, are usually safe at higher temperatures because of the lower intensity of the play.

Region 2 recommends that all associations have a clear policy in regard to heat and that each club within the association has a copy of the guidelines which determine whether or not play may be cancelled. What should also be clear as part of this policy is when a decision will be made and how that decision will be communicated to members.

To avoid dehydration, Sports Medicine Australia recommends athletes drink:

- Approximately 500mls (2 glasses) in the 2 hours prior to exercise
- During exercise longer than 60 minutes, 2-3 cups (500-700ml) of cool water or sports drink are sufficient for most sports.
- After exercise, replenish your fluid deficit to ensure you are fully re-hydrated, but not over-hydrated.

CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL:

- Each tournament will be conducted under the rules of Tennis Victoria. Tournament Committees and Referees shall have control of their respective tournament.
- Play will commence at 8.30am. (Doubles am: Singles pm).
- Players must report to Tournament Office on arrival.
- Players must not leave courts without permission.
- Players must wear recognized tennis wear and shoes.

2. AGE GROUP:

- Competitors must be either under or at that age by 31st January 2007. The 15 & over age group includes: All players that are too old for the 14 & under section and "of or under" 18 years of age by the 31st January 2007.
- Ages 10 & under, 12 & under, 14 & under and 15 & over for boys and girls. Tournament Organisers to check date of birth for all competitors.

3. ENTRY:

- Players may enter only one singles and doubles event, preferably in the same age group.
- Entry fees payable on arrival at courts: SINGLES \$4.00 & DOUBLES \$10.00 pair.
- Please make players aware that they must honour their entry unless extreme circumstances prevail. Please contact organizers of tournament if you are unable to attend their tournament after an entry has been placed.

CONDITIONS (cont.)

4. EVENT FORMAT:

- Singles events will be knock-out. All matches will consist of one 6 game set of normal tennis, tie-breakers at 5 all.
- Double events will be round robin. All double matches will consist of one 6 game, sudden death set, tie-breakers at 5 all. Double events must provide players with a minimum of three, and maximum of 5 matches. (In the case of only three pairs in an event, matches would be played to 8 – 7 all tiebreaker). Where there are three sections in an age group, final are to be played between the winners of each section and the next highest games winner.
- The Regional Tournament Coordinator must approve any alterations to the above format. (To be appointed by the Regional committee).

5. POINTS ALLOCATION:

- Points allocated to Region 2 Affiliated Tennis Victoria players only, based on performance. Tournament organizers must clearly mark any players not affiliated with Tennis Victoria, as they are ineligible to receive points.
- Winner players will receive 100 points, runner-up 80 points. All other players will receive 20 points for entry and 10 points per match that they win.

6. REFEREES:

- A Referee will be appointed and announced by the organizing Association/club at all tournaments.
- Where matches are played away from the main venue, additional referees shall be appointed to officiate at these venues.

7. HEAT POLICY:

- Tournament organizers shall adopt the heat policy of the Association/Club at which the Tournament is conducted.

8. PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Parents attending tournaments shall adopt and adhere to the "Codes of Conduct".
